Directions: In the book, *Fly on the Wall Series: Mayflower*, the Pilgrims travel from Leiden, Holland, to the New World on the *Mayflower*. Use the Internet to answer the following questions. (Hint: The bold words may help you find the answers.)

1. The Pilgrims left on a ship called the *Speedwell*, from Delfshaven, Holland. From there they sailed to Southampton, England, to meet up with the *Mayflower*. In what direction did they sail to get to England? _____ (Hint: You might need to Google a **Map of the Pilgrims' Journey in 1620**.)

2. Go to the website, **The Pilgrims & Plymouth Colony: 1620**. (Hint: Click on rootsweb.) Go to **Part II, Voyage of the *Mayflower***. Scroll down to **The Ship**. The *Mayflower* was a ship of how many **tuns**? _____ What is a **tun**?

3. Keep scrolling down to **details about The Ship**. Click and find out what part #10 is on the *Mayflower*. What is it called, and what is it really for?

4. Read the section about Christopher Jones: Master of the *Mayflower*. Why was the *Mayflower* called a “sweet ship”?

5. Now go to the Plimoth Plantation/*Mayflower II* website, www.plimoth.org.
